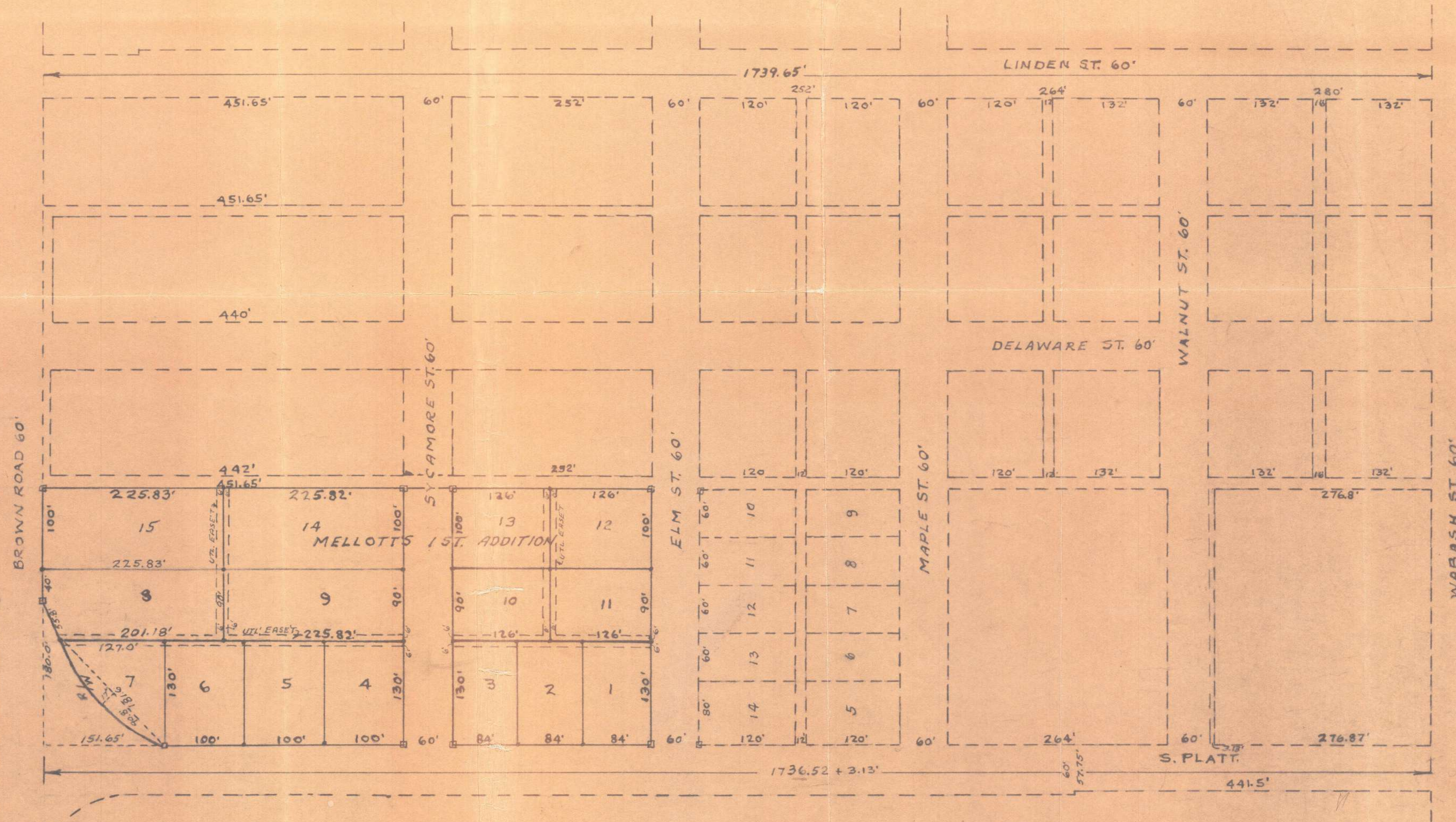


MELLOTT'S FIRST ADDITION
TO
VILLAGE OF MONTPELIER, OHIO



DESCRIPTION OF PLAT

Being a part of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of section 11, township 7 north, range 2 east, Williams County, Ohio, and further situated in the village of Montpelier, and bounded as follows:
Commencing at a cement monument set 60 ft south from the south east corner of lot # 14 in Clarks Addition in the village of Montpelier, and being the true point of beginning, said true point also being the southwest corner of Elm street and South Platt street; thence west on the south line of Elm street, a distance of 320 ft to a cement monument, said point being a point on the east line of a 14 ft alley; thence south on the east line of said alley, a distance of 763.65 ft to the north line of Brown Road; thence east 320 ft on the north line of Brown Road to the west line of South Platt street; thence north 763.65 ft on the west line of South Platt street to the true point of beginning.

DEDICATION OF PLAT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:
That we, George V. Mellogg and Dolores M. Mellogg, husband and wife, sole owners of the platted land shown hereon, have caused the same to be surveyed, laid out and platted, and same to be known as MELLOTT'S FIRST ADDITION to the village of Montpelier. We further dedicate the 12 ft easements shown hereon to the use of public utilities, for the construction and maintenance thereof. We further dedicate the streets shown hereon to the village of Montpelier for public use, including the land between the boundary line of lot # 7 and the southeast corner of the plat description.
